

FIRST SIX-MONTH REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF WORK PACKAGE 1

Basic activities during the implementation of Work Package 1 are aligned with its basic outcome:

D1.2. Monograph: *Challenges on the global economic scene: the world economy after Covid-19 and Ukraine* (M12)

A search of available data and relevant literature was carried out, and it was found that the title and content of the monograph need to be modified, for the following reasons:

- a) The available sources can be considered conditionally reliable, because there are different, often contradictory opinions about global events, as well as about their consequences, and the project team considers it advisable not to use sources that may have political connotations or to prepare a monograph that can be considered debatable on any basis;
- b) It is far more advisable to prepare a monograph that will be more narrowly oriented to the area the project deals with: circular economy, and within it, sustainable economic and energy development;
- c) Furthermore, it is much more useful to prepare a monograph that will deal with the Balkan region, which will also include the Republic of Serbia.

Therefore, the project team adopts the proposal to **make certain changes** in the title and content of the monograph, which now reads:

D1.2. Monograph: *Challenges on the global stage: sustainable economic and energy development of the Balkan region* (M12)

It is planned that the monograph will be published in M12 of the project. A preliminary content was prepared and a draft of the monograph was prepared and approved by the project team.
