

THIRD SIX-MONTH REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF WORK PACKAGE 1

Basic activities during the implementation of Work Package 1 are aligned with its basic outcome:

D1.2. Monograph: *Challenges on the global economic scene: the world economy after Covid-19 and Ukraine* (M12)

During the implementation of the project, there was a need to make certain changes in the title of the monograph, and the explanation was submitted to the Foundation for Science as part of the submission of the narrative part of the annual report.

A book was published "*Sustainable development, green transition of Europe and the Western Balkans: challenges and perspectives*".

Description of the monograph:

The monograph will first show the problems in the implementation of sustainable development on a global level, with an indication of the risks that appear on that basis.

Furthermore, the monograph will provide an overview of the regulatory framework and starting points for the green transition of the European Union, with an emphasis on the analysis of the possibility of its full implementation and pointing out the problems that have appeared or can be expected in the future.

After that, the monograph focuses on the Western Balkans and the Republic of Serbia. Namely, the Republic of Serbia is part of the Western Balkan region, with which it shares history, infrastructure and represents a kind of marketplace. In addition, the challenges of the green transition are such that they cannot be viewed in isolation, or only at the level of one country.

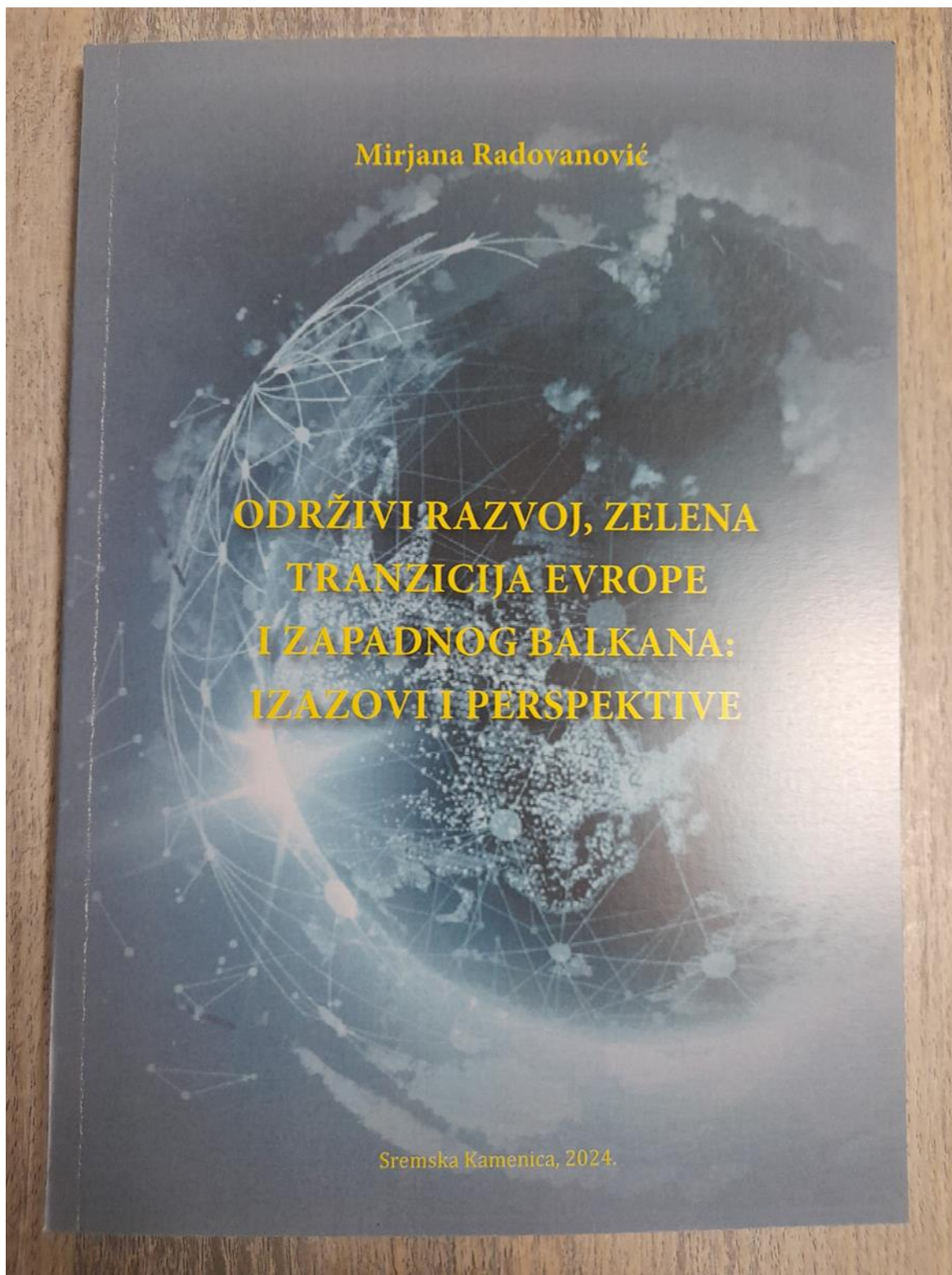

Namely, our University (like most in Serbia) has included certain courses in the field of green transition in its curricula, but adequate literature, especially in the area of risks in that process, is still missing.
